Good-looking sausages with a lovely balance of well-seasoned flavours. Great meaty texture, with no gristly or large fatty lumps. A worthy winner.

### THE RUNNERS-UP

#### 34/50 Waitrose Premium Pork Sausages

Thinner sausages with a gentle flavour. A good all-rounder.  
£2.09 for 454g

#### 33/50 Black Farmer Premium Pork Sausages

Firm, with a smooth, slightly rubbery texture and no gristle. Some testers found them too peppery. They brown well.  
£2.79 for 400g, available from major supermarkets

#### 32/50 Marks & Spencer Outdoor Bred Pork Sausages

Good for those who like a strong flavour. Skin a little tough.  
£2.69 for 400g

#### 31/50 Co-op Truly Irresistible British Pork Sausages

A little pale, with over-processed meat. Taste better than they look.  
£2.79 for 400g
